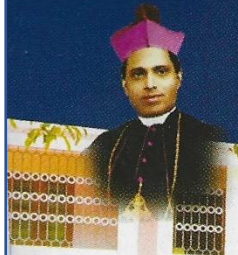
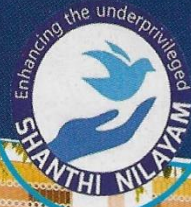

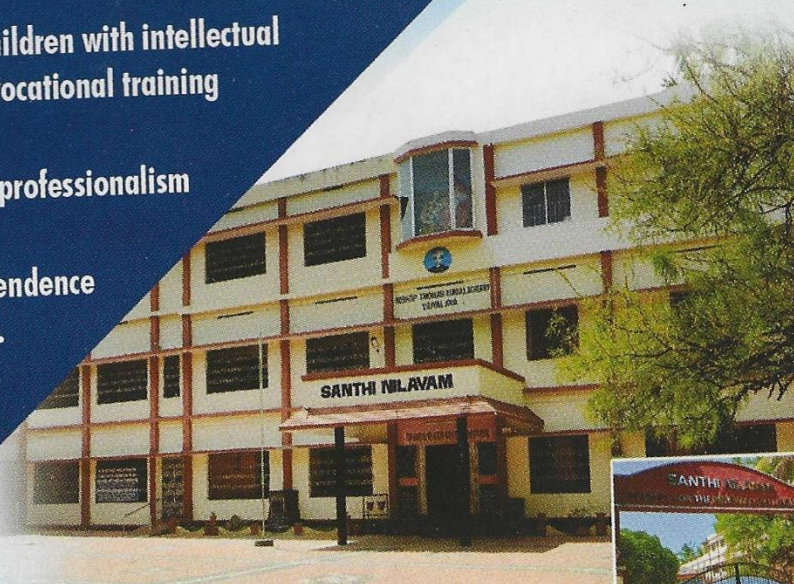

We started this school at Paruthivilai to improve the living condition of children with Intellectual Disability. We are working under Syro - Malabar Catholic Diocese of Thuckalay. 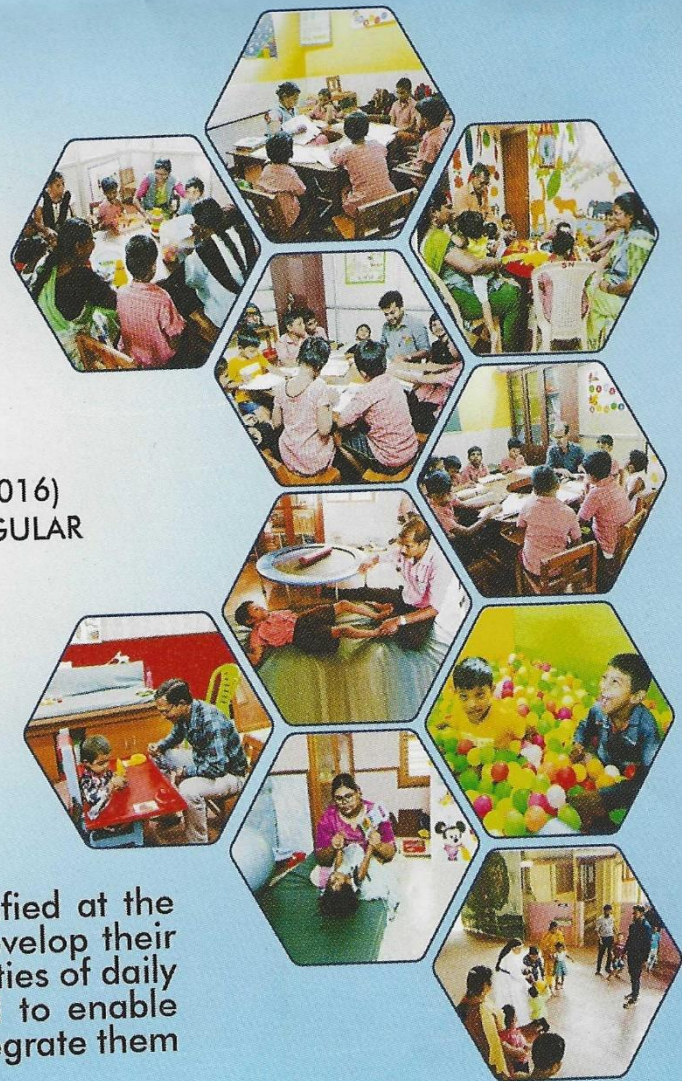

## EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAMME (0 to 6 years of Age)

Children having delayed milestone are identified at the earliest and given early intervention services to develop their social, cognitive, sensory and language skills. Activities of daily living skills, functional skills training are provided to enable them to achieve the near to normal life so as to integrate them in the regular schooling.



## SPECIAL SCHOOL PROGRAMME

6 to 18 years of age children who could not cope with the regular school curriculum continue their education at the special school where they learn functional skill, basic academic skill, Personal skills & Social skills. Co-curricular activities like sports, Dance, Music, Drawing & Colouring etc are conducted to develop their comprehensive and creative skills.

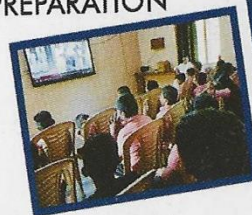

The early, timely and systematic therapeutic intervention helps the children with intellectual disability to develop appropriate physical and mental coordination. ## Medical Intervention

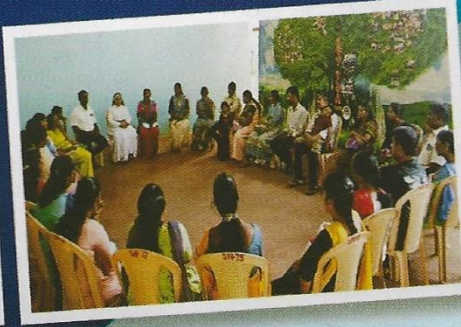
Medical check-up and follow-up are done each month with the guidelines of the general physician and the specialist Doctors.

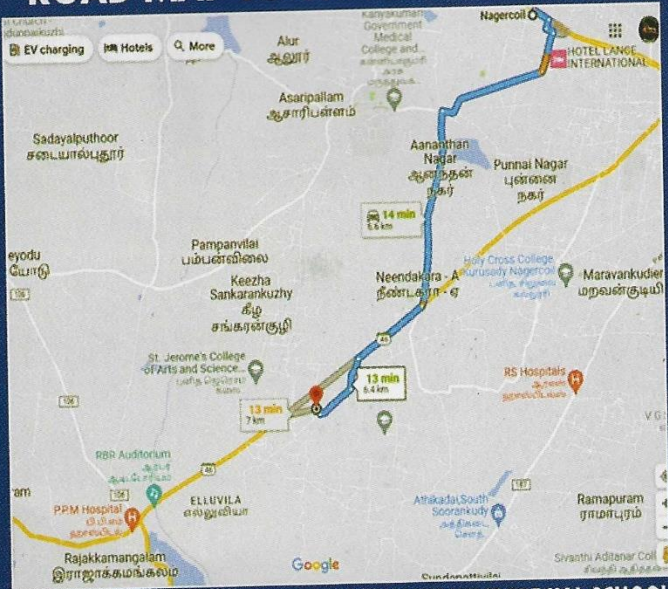
